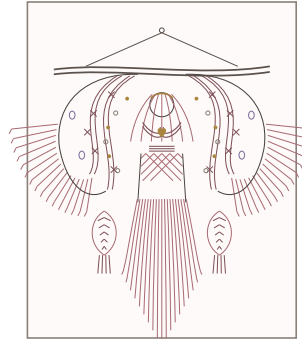


The Rosewood Angel - Quick Reference

A Javoews House pattern | Advanced | 26 x 30 in | 12-16 hrs (4-5 sessions, beginner-to-intermediate)

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

- 5 mm cotton cord, dusty rose - approx. 250 yd / 230 m
- Driftwood branch 30 in / 76 cm
- 25 mm wooden bead (head) + gold filigree heart charm
- 14 gold beads, 10 pearls (8 mm), 4 amethyst chips
- 4 wire-wrapped quartz points + 1 m gold cord (halo)
- Shears, comb, T-pins, project board, tapestry needle

CORD CUTTING QUICK-REF

Grp	Purpose	Qty	Cut
A	Wing carriers (DHH)	16	3.5 m
B	Feather fringe	20	1.2 m
C	Body core	12	4.0 m
D	Skirt fringe	30	1.6 m
E	Leaf tassels	12	1.0 m
F	Hair/arms/wraps	10	1.5 m

KNOT ABBREVIATIONS

LHK	Lark's head - mounting
RLH	Reverse lark's head - adding fringe
SK / ASK	Square knot / alternating - bodice lattice
DHH	Diagonal double half hitch - wings & leaves
WK	Wrapping knot - arms, waist, hanger
OK	Overhand - bead locks
RK	Rya knot - skirt & feather fringe

BUILD ORDER

#	Section	Time
1	Hanging cord & mounting row	30 min
2	Head, halo & hair	1 hr
3	Arms & heart charm	1 hr
4	Waist wrap & lattice bodice	1.5 hr
5	Wing carrier twists (L, then R)	3-4 hr ea
6	Wing feather fringe	in 5
7	Leaf tassels	1 hr
8	Skirt fringe	1 hr
9	Beads, crystals & finishing	30 min

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

- 1 Cutting cords to exact length - always add 3-4 in; twist rows eat cord fast.
- 2 Skipping pins on the wing rails - unpinned turns collapse the wave shape.
- 3 Pulling twist-eye hitches tight - the eyes must stay open for beads.
- 4 Trimming skirt/fringe on the table - hang the piece first, then cut.
- 5 Building wing 2 from memory - check against wing 1 after every wave.
