FINISHED SIZE

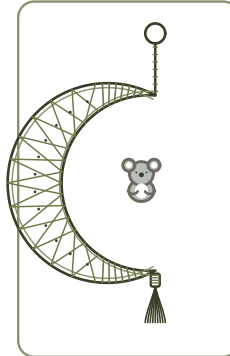
7.5 × 21 in (19 × 53 cm)

BUILD TIME

6–8 hrs — 2–3 evening sessions (lattice is the long sit)

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

60 yd • 3 mm cotton, olive sage
72 in • 8 mm rope + floral wire
2 in wooden ring
koala plush ≈4.5 in seated
gray thread, glue, comb, shears

Build Order

#	Section	Time
1	Shape crescent core	30 m
2	Wrap the frame	2 h
3	Hanger & ring	20 m
4	Mount 22 lattice cords	20 m
5	Diamond lattice band	3 h
6	Bottom tassel	30 m
7	Koala perch & finish	40 m

Cord Cutting Quick-Ref

L	Purpose	Qty	Cut
A	Core rope + wire	1	72 in
B	Frame wraps	3	6 yd
C	Lattice cords	22	45 in
D	Hanger wrap	1	60 in
E	Tassel cords	12	16 in
F	Wrap knots	2	24 in

Cut 3–4 in longer than listed. Total 3 mm ≈ 54 yd.

Knot Abbreviations

LHK	Lark's Head — mounts cords on frame
SK	Square Knot — fills diamond centers
DHH	Double Half Hitch — closes onto inner arc
DDHH	Diagonal DHH — draws diamond outlines
WK	Wrapping Knot — tassel collar, 8 coils
OK	Overhand — seeds ends, koala loop

Top 5 Mistakes to Avoid

1. Wrapping loose — seat coils every 10 wraps or core shows
2. Letting the DDHH holding cord sag — keep it taut at 45°
3. Mounting cords into the tip tapers — they stay bare wrap
4. Cutting tassel strands before combing & steaming
5. Anchoring the koala at one point — it will tip forward
