

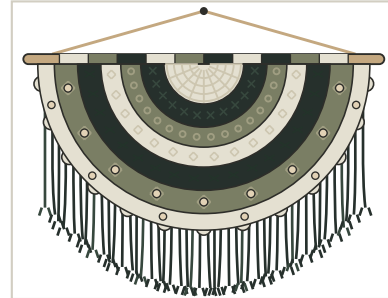

Build time (intermediate-advanced): 12-16 hours / 4-5 evening sessions · Finished 30" x 30" on a 36" dowel

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

4 mm single-strand cotton: deep green ~235 yd,
sage ~100 yd, cream ~160 yd
36" x 3/4" wooden dowel · 14 x 20 mm wood beads
Shears, comb, T-pins, foam board, tape measure

BUILD ORDER

#	Zone	Work
1	Mount	hanger, fringe, groups, wrap dowel
2	Z1	cream coil medallion
3	Z2	green square-knot arc
4	Z3	sage chain arc (DHH)
5	Z4	cream ASK net arc
6	Z5	green DHH lattice arc
7	Z6	sage bead diamonds (7 beads)
8	Z7	picot scallop edge (7 beads)
9	F	shape fringe, brush, steam, trim

KNOT ABBREVIATIONS

LH	Lark's Head — fold, loop over dowel, ends through
SK	Square Knot — left over, right under, reverse to lock
ASK	Alternating SK — offset rows, opens a net
DHH	Diagonal Double Half Hitch — 2 wraps on angled leader
WK	Wrapping Knot — coil bundle, tail hidden in loop
OK	Overhand — single loop through; ends & hanger

CORD CUTTING QUICK-REF

Grp	Use / color	Qty	Cut
A	Medallion — cream	10	4 yd
B	Arcs Z2/Z5 — green	24	5.5 yd
C	Arcs Z3/Z6 — sage	20	5 yd
D	Arcs Z4/Z7 — cream	18	5 yd
E	Leaders — cream	6	2.5 yd
F	Fringe — green	40	2.5 yd
G	Wrap + hanger — mixed	4	4 yd
TOTAL		122	493 yd

Cut everything 3-4" longer than listed.

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

1. Hitching to your hand, not the pinned curve — arcs flatten. Re-pin every 6 knots.
2. Skipping the dry-fit on beads — a tight 20 mm bead kinks its diamond.
3. Even-length fringe cut on the table — hang 24 h, then trim the V on the wall.
4. Tightening picot loops with the SK — pin loops open, snug only the knot.
5. Mixing sage dye lots — buy all sage at once or the middle bands go muddy.

SESSION PLANNER

S1: mount + wrap + medallion (2.5-3 h)
S2: arcs Z2-Z3 (3 h) · S3: arcs Z4-Z5 (3-4 h)
S4: beads + picot edge (2.5 h)
S5: fringe + finishing (1.5-2 h)
