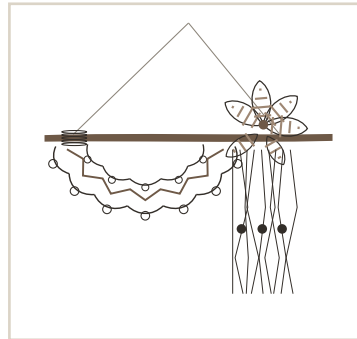


Floral Crescent Mini Wall Hanging - Quick Reference

Intermediate | ~16 x 13 in | Estimated build: 4-6 hours / 2 evening sessions

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

3 mm single-twist cotton, ecru - ~75 yd total
Driftwood branch ~16 in / 40 cm
Scissors, comb/pet brush, T-pins, foam board
Optional: fabric stiffener for petals

CORD CUTTING QUICK-REF

A Outer arc	8 x 45 in
B Inner arc	6 x 40 in
C Swag	4 x 60 in
D Flower	12 x 30 in
E Leaves	8 x 24 in
F Fringe	10 x 28 in
G Wrap/gathers	2 x 70 in
H Hanger	1 x 30 in

Cut everything 3-4 in longer than listed.

KNOT ABBREVIATIONS

LHK - Lark's Head: mounts folded cords
DHH - Double Half Hitch: arcs, petals, leaves
HK - Half Knot (repeated): the twisted swag
SK - Square Knot: gathers the flower center
WK - Wrapping Knot: branch coil + gathers
OK - Overhand Knot: fringe stopper knots

BUILD ORDER

1 Hanger + branch wrap	20 min
2 Mount all cord groups	25 min
3 Outer scallop arc - 7 bumps	60-80 min
4 Inner picot arc - 5 bumps	45-60 min
5 Twisted swag - ~28 HKs	30 min
6 Flower (4 petals) + 2 leaves	75-90 min
7 Fringe cascade + finishing	40 min

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

1. Alternating half knots on the swag - it kills the spiral. Tie the SAME knot every time.
2. Pulling picot loops out - pin each 0.5 in loop before tying the next DHH.
3. Uneven holding-cord tension - re-pin the arc often so all 7 bumps match.
4. Trimming fringe before combing - unravel and comb first, then one long taper cut.
5. Skipping the level check - hang the branch from the H cord before knotting anything.
