Fox Bookmark Wall Hanging - Quick Reference

A Javoews House pattern | 3-4 hours / 1-2 evening sessions per fox (beginner-to-intermediate)



Inspiration



Finished pattern

Materials & supplies

3 mm single-twist cotton: rust 28 yd, cream 5-10 yd
Black wood beads: 2 x 10 mm eyes, 1 x 12-14 mm nose
Anchor cord 24 in, project board, T-pins, pet brush

Build order

- 1 Mount A-B-C-B-A on anchor
- 2 Ear triangles (DDHH)
- 3 Forehead chevron x3
- 4 Cream muzzle (SK taper)
- 5 Thread eye + nose beads
- 6 Body outline egg (DDHH)
- 7 Infill: V1 bundle / V2 lattice
- 8 Gathering wrap (WK)
- 9 Tassel, trim, loop

Knot abbreviations

LH	Lark's Head
SK	Square Knot
DDHH	Double Half Hitch
ASK	Alternating Square Knot
WK	Wrap (Gathering) Knot
RT	Rya (Tassel) Knot

Version switch

Lbl	Purpose	Qty	Cut length
A	Ears, rust	8	55 in / 140 cm
B	Head, rust	6	50 in / 127 cm
C	Muzzle, cream	4	40 in / 100 cm
D	Body carriers	2	45 in / 115 cm
E	Tassel pack	12	14 in / 36 cm
F	Wrap + loop	2	26 in / 66 cm

34 cords / approx 33.5 yd per fox - cut 3-4 in long

- Mounting gaps - keep all 18 heads touching on the anchor
- Crossing chevron carriers left-over-right (it is right over left)
- Beads after the body - thread eyes and nose BEFORE section 6
- Uneven lattice gaps (V2) - use a 12 mm card spacer
- Under-wrapped hips - 8-10 turns minimum or the tassel drops

V1: solid chevron + bundle body, rust tassel
V2: open ASK lattice body (12 mm gaps), cream tassel
Bookmark: skip loop, stiffen back with dilute fabric glue
