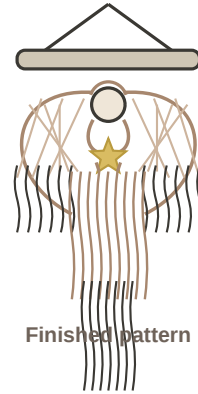


Ivory Star Angel - Quick Reference

Build time (beginner-to-intermediate): 6-9 hours / 2-3 evening sessions - Beginner-Intermediate - 10" W x 20" L (25 x 51 cm) incl. dowel

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

- 3mm single-twist cotton string, natural/ivory - approx. 130 yd (119 m) total
- Bamboo dowel 14" x 5/8", with brass end caps (or plain dowel + brass paint)
- 30mm unfinished wooden bead (head), 8mm hole
- 1 brass or gold-tone star charm, ~1", top-drilled
- 2 x 8mm natural wooden beads (one per wing)

CORD CUTTING QUICK-REF

- A** 12 x 9 ft (2.7 m) - Wings (working cords)
- B** 6 x 10 ft (3.0 m) - Body, head & hands
- C** 10 x 6 ft (1.8 m) - Top skirt layer
- D** 12 x 8 ft (2.4 m) - Under-skirt fringe
- E** 4 x 6 ft (1.8 m) - Hanger, braid crown, wraps

348 ft ≈ 116 yd - buy 130 yd for trim allowance

KNOT ABBREVIATIONS

- LHK** Lark's Head Knot - Fold cord in half, push loop over the dowel
- SK** Square Knot - Left cord over the two fillers and under the
- ASK** Alternating Square Knot - Work a row of SKs, then drop 2 cords and bor
- DHH** Double Half Hitch - Loop the working cord over the carrier twice
- WK** Wrapped Knot - Lay a loop along the bundle, wrap firmly dow
- GK** Gathering Knot - A wrapped knot used to cinch a group of cord
- OK** Overhand Knot - Simple single loop-through knot; secures bea

BUILD ORDER

1. Hanger + mount groups A and B on the dowel
2. Head: thread the bead, form the braid crown
3. Praying hands loop + hang the star charm
4. Lattice wings: ASK net + wing bead, then fringe (left, mirror right)
5. Waist gather (WK)
6. Two-layer skirt: top layer over long under-fringe
7. Finishing: brush, trim, steam

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

- Tight square knots - this lattice must stay loose and airy
- No gap between body and wing groups on the dowel
- Cutting the top skirt as long as the under-skirt
- Locking the star with a loose OK - it will spin backward
- Ironing natural cotton - steam only, heat yellows it
