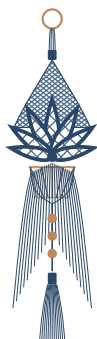


Indigo Lotus Plant Hanger — Quick Reference

Intermediate · Approx. 12" wide x 42" long (30 x 107 cm), fits a 5-6" pot · Build time: 8-11 hours / 3 evening sessions

Materials at a glance

- ~165 yd 4mm single-twist cotton, deep indigo
- 2.5" wooden ring · 3 wood beads (20-25mm, 8mm+ hole)
- Terracotta pot 5-6" · board & T-pins, shears, comb/brush, tape measure

Cut every cord 3-4" longer than charted.

Build order

- 1 Mounting — Loop, lark's heads on the ring, neck wrap
- 2 Top triangle panel — ASK mesh bounded by DCH edges
- 3 Lotus petals — 7 petals: DCH outlines, ASK fill
- 4 Lotus center & base row — Berry-knot center, DHH base ridge
- 5 Pot cradle — SK sinnets + alternating net, sized to pot
- 6 Fringe skirt — Rya knots on a holding cord, V trim
- 7 Beaded core & tassel — 3 beads, gathered tassel
- 8 Finishing — Steam, trim, brush, hang & level

Cord cutting quick-ref

A	Ring-mounted working cords (triangle + lotus)	8	4.5 yd	36 yd
B	Petal filler cords (added at petals)	8	3 yd	24 yd
C	Pot cradle cords	8	3.5 yd	28 yd
D	Fringe skirt cords	30	48 in	40 yd
E	Tassel cords	12	54 in	18 yd
F	Loop, neck wrap, tassel wrap, petal holders	7	1.5 yd	10.5 yd
TOTAL		73 cords		~157 yd

Knot abbreviations

- LHK** Lark's Head Knot — Fold cord in half, loop over the ring, pull both ends through.
- SK** Square Knot — Two half knots, mirrored, tied around filler cords. Keep fillers.
- ASK** Alternating Square Knot — Each new row borrows two cords from neighboring cords to form a fringe bundle over the holding cord and pull ends through.
- DHH** Double Half Hitch — Two hitches per cord over a horizontal holding cord. Make sure you
- DCH** Diagonal Clove Hitch — DHH worked over a holding cord held at an angle — draw through.
- SKF** Sinnet Knot — Fold a fringe bundle over the holding cord and pull ends through.
- SKF** Sinnet Knot — Rolled 6-SK sinnet secured through itself — the lotus center.

Top 5 mistakes to avoid

1. Cutting cords exactly to chart length — always add 3-4" of insurance.
2. Rushing petal DCH tension — uneven hitches ruin the petal outline.
3. Skipping the pot test-fit before closing the cradle GK.
4. Trimming the fringe V before combing it flat.
5. Hanging in direct sun — indigo fades fast.
