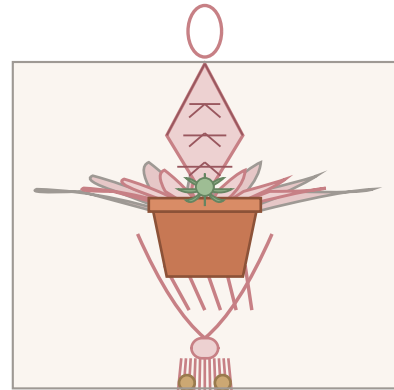

AT A GLANCE

Skill: Intermediate
Size: 9" W x 22" L
Cord: 3mm cotton, ~77 yd
Dowel: 8" / driftwood
Pot: 2.5-3" terracotta
Beads: 2-3 wood
Build: 10-14 hrs
3-4 evening sessions



Finished pattern

Build Order

#	Section
1	Mount cords (LH), center-out
2	Crown diamond + loop
3	Back petal fan (7)
4	Front petal row
5	Body lattice diamond
6	Pot cradle + V-weave
7	Gather, beads, tassel
8	Block & seat plant

Cord Cutting

	Purpose	Qty	Length
A	Crown & loop	2	110"
B	Back petals	14	70"
C	Front petals	14	58"
D	Body lattice	6	64"
E	Cradle/tassel	8	46"
	TOTAL	44	~77 yd

Knot Abbreviations

LH - Lark's Head (mounting)
HSK - Half Square Knot (spiral)
GK - Gathering / Wrap Knot

SK - Square Knot
DHH - Diagonal Double Half Hitch
OK - Overhand Knot (bead anchor)

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

1. Skipping the steam-block - petals will curl and the lotus won't lie flat.
2. Mounting cords off-center - the whole bloom hangs crooked. Work center-out.
3. Loose cradle net - the pot slips through. Add a square-knot row and tighten the V.
4. Cutting cords to exact length - always add 3-4". Dense knotting eats cord fast.
5. Freehand tassel trim - comb straight, tape a guide line, cut against it.
