

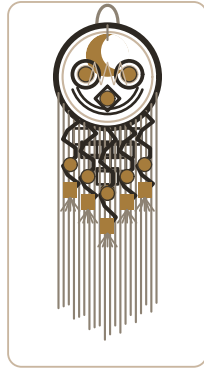

Crescent Moon Dreamcatcher — Quick Reference

A Javoews House pattern · Intermediate · 8–11 hours / 3 evening sessions

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

- 4 mm single-twist cotton string, ecru — ≈152 yd
- 10" (25 cm) metal hoop, gold
- Wooden crescent moon charm, ≈3"
- 9 gold beads, 10–12 mm (hole ≥ 8 mm)
- Shears · yarn needle · pet brush · tape
- Finished: ≈10" W × 27" L (25 × 69 cm)

Cut every cord 3–4" longer than listed.

BUILD ORDER

#	Section	Time
1	Hoop wrap & hanger	45 m
2	Moon charm suspension	10 m
3	Mount medallion cords B ×14	20 m
4	Upper arc net (ASK)	1 h
5	Eye circles ×2 (DHH + bead)	1.5 h
6	Center diamond (DHH + bead)	45 m
7	Fringe mount + V-panel	1.5 h
8	Spiral drops ×5 (HKS)	2 h
9	Fringe trim, brush, finish	1 h

KNOT ABBREVIATIONS

LHK	Lark's head — fold, loop over hoop, pull through
SK	Square knot — left half + right half, flat
ASK	Alternating SK — borrow 2 cords per neighbor
HKS	Half-knot spiral — same half knot, lets it twist
DHH	Diagonal clove hitch — 2 hitches over a filler
GK	Gathering wrap — 5–6 wraps, tail through loop
OK	Overhand — single loop and through

CORD CUTTING QUICK-REF

Lbl	Purpose	Qty	Cut
A	Hoop wrap	1	6 yd
B	Medallion cords	14	3.5 yd
C	Fringe / drops	22	2.5 yd
D	Spiral extenders	5	4 yd
E	Moon charm hanger	1	18 in
F	Wall hanger loop	1	24 in
G	Tassel fills	50	12 in
H	Wrap-knot cords	6	24 in
TOT		100	≈152 yd

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

1. Loose hoop wraps — pack them every 2" or metal shows
2. Starting half knots from both sides — spirals reverse
3. Egg-shaped eye rings — re-tension filler at halfway
4. Loose ASK net — snug each knot before the next row
5. Over-brushing fringe — bottom 2–3" only, then steam
