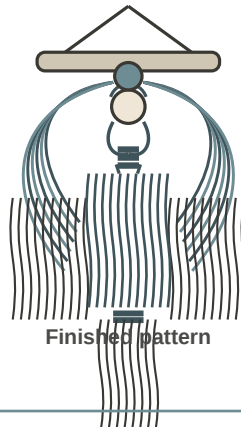


Teal Halo Angel - Quick Reference

Build time (beginner-to-intermediate): 8-12 hours / 3-4 evening sessions - Intermediate - 13" W x 24" L (33 x 61 cm) incl. dowel

MATERIALS AT A GLANCE

- 4mm single-twist cotton string, deep teal - approx. 210 yd (192 m) total
- Hardwood dowel 16" x 3/4", stained ebony/black
- 1 ceramic or glazed bead, 30-35mm, aqua (the halo)
- hole 8mm+
- Tools: shears, cord comb, T-pins + foam board, measuring tape

CORD CUTTING QUICK-REF

- A** 20 x 11 ft (3.4 m) - Wing fringe curtain
 - B** 8 x 5 ft (1.5 m) - Wing arc carriers
 - C** 8 x 10 ft (3.0 m) - Body, head & arms
 - D** 16 x 8 ft (2.4 m) - Tier-1 skirt
 - E** 12 x 7 ft (2.1 m) - Tier-2 skirt drop
 - F** 5 x 6 ft (1.8 m) - Hanger, head wrap, wraps
- 582 ft ≈ 194 yd - buy 210 yd for trim allowance

KNOT ABBREVIATIONS

- LHK** Lark's Head Knot - Fold cord in half, push loop over the dowel
- SK** Square Knot - Left cord over the two fillers and under the
- DHH** Double Half Hitch - Loop the working cord over the carrier twice
- HH** Half Hitch - A single loop over the carrier — half of a D
- WK** Wrapped Knot - Lay a loop along the bundle, wrap firmly dow
- GK** Gathering Knot - A wrapped knot used to cinch a group of cord
- OK** Overhand Knot - Simple single loop-through knot; secures bea

BUILD ORDER

1. Hanger + mount groups A, B, C on the dowel
2. Halo: thread the ceramic bead above the head wrap
3. Head wrap + braided crown
4. Swoop wings: 4 stacked DHH arc carriers per side over the fringe curtain
5. Arms loop + wrapped waist
6. Two-tier tassel skirt
7. Finishing: brush, trim, steam

TOP 5 MISTAKES TO AVOID

- Letting the swoop carrier go slack mid-row - keep it pinned taut
- Mounting the body block off the dowel midpoint
- Hitching the tier-2 anchor too tight - it warps tier 1
- Trimming the wing curtain before all 4 arcs are set
- Skipping side light - dark cord hides bad loops
